TERMS OF SALE (the fine print)

Reservation Policy

Reservations may be made by telephone. Telephone reservations will be held 10 days pending receipt of deposit. We require a fifty per cent (50%) with your reservation. The balance of the trip fee is due ten days before trip date. Reservations made within two weeks of trip date require immediate full payment.

Cancellations

If you cancel your reservation, you may be eligible for a partial/full refund. Our cancellation policy is firm. We operate under stringent federal, state and local regulations, which restrict the number of guests per trip and the number of trips per season. We incur substantial expenses before each trip departs. If you must cancel your reservation on a California river, a full refund will be made only if your cancellation is made at least 30 days before the trip. A full refund will be made if we are forced to cancel the trip due to weather or river condition, insufficient reservations or other circumstances beyond our control.

Performance

It is sometimes necessary for Rubicon Whitewater Adventures to cancel or modify a trip because of unusual circumstances. We reserve the right to cancel or modify any trip due to weather/water conditions or other circumstances beyond our control. In such cases we cannot be responsible for paying personal or trip related expenses, other than refunding fees paid to Rubicon Whitewater Adventures.

Participant Health

Our river trips are suitable for most persons in good health. However, We have no way to determine your health condition. When you sign up for a river trip you take the responsibility to confirm that you are in reasonably good physical condition with out conditions or medications that would increase your risk when participating in a river trip. If you suffer allergic reactions or are on medications--we need to know. Call us if you have any questions regarding this matter. Trip participants must understand and appreciate that river rafting, shore camping, and related activities involve certain inherent risks. Rubicon Whitewater Adventures assumes no liability for injury, fatality, property damage or loss consequential to these risks. To reserve a position on a river trip all participants must an assumption of risk and liability release agreement. Read the agreement carefully before you sign or send money.

Vacation Insurance

We recommend that all trip participants purchase vacation insurance. In addition to the physical risks of river trips, you may have financial loss if you have to cancel your trip.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT

This is a release. Read it carefully and sign below. This release essentially says that I know I am going on a whitewater rafting trip, not a Disneyland ride or a trip to an air-conditioned shopping mall. If I die, get hurt, or damage my belongings, I will not make a claim, sue or expect Rubicon Whitewater Adventures, its owners, operators, agents, employees, and associates to be legally responsible or pay for any damages.

I, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily chosen to go on this whitewater rafting trip with Rubicon Whitewater Adventures. I know and fully understand that a whitewater rafting trip, whether on a raft, an oar boat, a kayak or any other type of vessel, is an outdoor adventure activity that will inherent risks and hazards where serious accidents can occur, participants can die, sustain injuries and property damage. I acknowledge and willingly assume all risks and hazards in whitewater rafting and river related camping, including but not limited to, loss of control of the raft, collision with other participants, rocks, trees and any portion of the interior of the raft, other rafts and any other manmade or natural obstacles whether they are obvious or not: submission in water, drowning, encounters with animals, wildlife and insects, exposure to extreme temperatures and inclement weather, wilderness terrain and unavailability of immediate medical attention in case of injury.

I understand that Class IV and V rapids represent the most difficult and dangerous levels of whitewater and recognize that the risks associated with whitewater rafting are increased. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to do so at my own risk.

In consideration for Rubicon Whitewater Adventures allowing me to participate on this trip, I voluntarily agree to release, discharge and hold harmless Rubicon Whitewater Adventures and their owners, officers, employees, agents and regulating agencies including but not limited to California State Parks, U.S. Forest Service, El Dorado County, and riparian land owners for any and all claims of liability arising out of their negligence, recklessness, strict liability, breach of contract, or any other act or omission which causes the undersigned illness or injury, death, and damages of any nature in any way connected with my participation in this activity. I also expressly agree to release and discharge Rubicon Whitewater Adventures, their owners, officers, agents, and employees from any act or omission of negligence in rendering or failing to render any type of emergency or medical services. In signing this document, I fully recognize and understand if I (or any minor on whose behalf I am signing this release) is hurt, die, or my property is damaged, I am giving up my right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against Rubicon Whitewater Adventures, its agents, employees and all other parties and affiliates named herein even if they negligently or by some other act or omission cause injury or damage.

As a parent or legal guardian of a participant under 10 years of age, I have read and voluntarily agreed that the said minor may participate in this whitewater rafting trip and I sign this release on their behalf. In addition, I give Rubicon Whitewater Adventures, its owners, employees or associates permission to treat the said minor in case of illness,

injury, emergency, or accident. Should emergency medical services become necessary, for the undersigned participant or minor, the expenses are the sole responsibility of the participant and not that of Rubicon Whitewater Adventures. Personal medical and travel insurance is strongly advised.

Rubicon Whitewater Adventures reserves the right to accept or deny service to any person. I hereby agree to follow all rules, regulations, and instructions of Rubicon Whitewater Adventures while on this trip. I also certify that I and any minor, on whose behalf I am signing, are physically and mentally capable of participating in these activities. I hereby agree that Rubicon Whitewater Adventures, may use film or photographic records of this rafting trip for its promotional and or commercial purposes.

I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. I UNDERSTAND I AM ASSUMING ALL RISKS INHERENT WITH WHITEWATER RAFTING. I VOLUNTARILY SIGN MY NAME AS EVIDENCE OF MY ACCEPTANCE OF THE ABOVE PROVISIONS.
