

Trinity River Directions:

From the South

north on Hwy 101, eight miles past Eureka. Take the Hwy 299 exit at the north end of Arcata. Follow 299, , past Willow Creek, past Big Bar, 11 miles past Big Flat to Big Foot Campground. (aprox 1.25 hours from 101)

Bay Area: It is generally quickest to go to I-80, and take the 505 cutoff to I-5,north. To 299 west (Weaverville-Eureka) aproximatey 11 miles west of Weaverville

GENERAL INFORMATION

We always meet at Big Foot Campground, usually the morning before the trip. Folks need to make their own reservations if coming up the day before.

Check the "what to bring" list in your brochure. Leave jewelry at home (especially rings).
